

## **ANNOUNCEMENT**

Dr Ausaf Sayeed, The Ambassador of India and Patron of International Indian Schools, wishes well for good health of entire fraternity of International Indian Schools and the Indian Community in Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Further to our circular of 20 April 2020, constant monitoring of developments related to COVID-19 situation in the Kingdom, recommendations of the Higher Board, Managing Committees and internal deliberations, following decisions have been taken for the Schools.

All measures announced vide our circular of 20 April 2020, shall stay in effect till 21 June 2020. The situation will be reviewed subsequent to restrictions being eased in the Kingdom, in concert with the Ministry of Education directives.

Following measures are reiterated: -

- All Schools have been advised to continue the School outreach and be sympathetic to the requirements and assistance projected by parents.
- All students will be allowed to access online classes irrespective of fee default. No restrictions will be applied.
- Only tuition fee to be paid by parents. All subsidiary/ supplementary fees shall not be charged. Parents are however, advised to clear the fee dues at the earliest.
- The costs for implementation of distance learning package will be considered through tuition fees for the lockdown period.

Higher Board shall be issuing necessary directions to all International Indian Schools in this regard. The emerging situation and concessions provided shall be reviewed on 21 June 2020.

Similar steps are recommended to be adopted by all CBSE Schools in the Kingdom which are privately owned.
