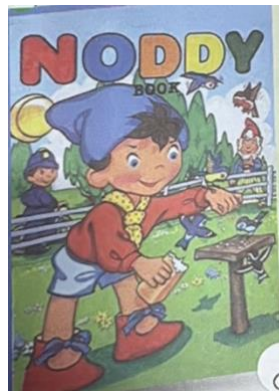
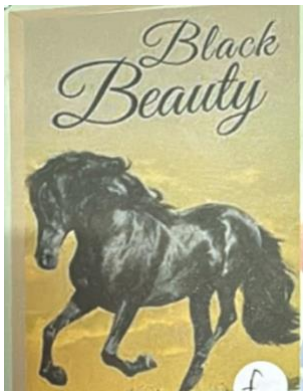

6. He invented the first telephone in 1876. He invented many things including the deaf-aid.

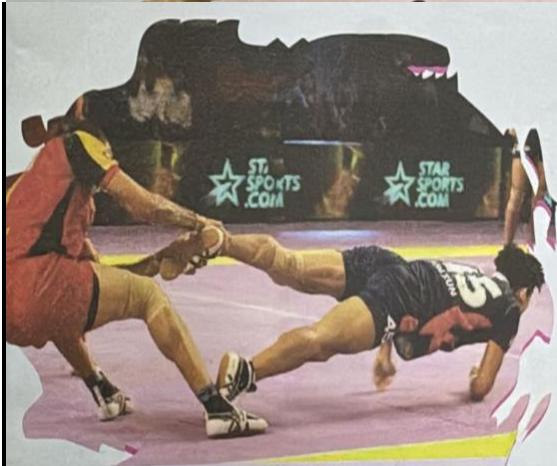

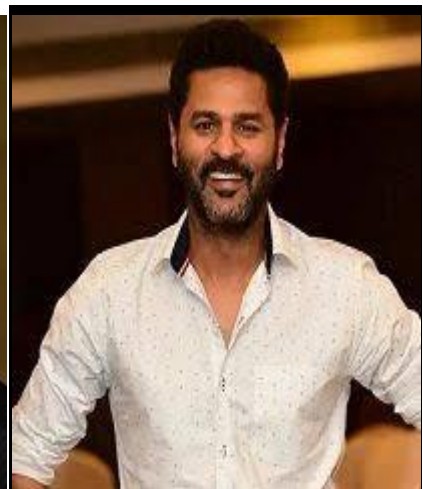
