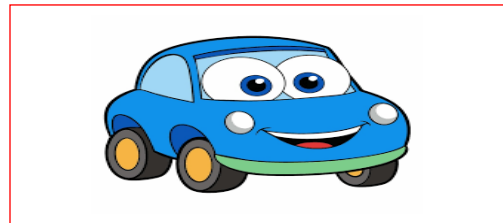

An adjective is a word that describes noun. Adjectives tell us about colour, size, shape, taste, weight and touch.
