Q1. Name four tasks of the governorates.

Ans. 1. Handle criminal cases, public and private rights and execute orders.

2. Maintain internal security, report accidents and natural disasters and enforce security.
3. Transfer opponents to legal courts.
4. Submit periodic report to the Region Prince regarding the Governorate activities and required services.

Q2. What are the features of the Governorates ?

Ans. Governorates are related to the Region's Prince and his representative. These Governorates are located in the cities and villages that are administratively related to the region and they represent the Emirate in solving all the region's issues.

Q3. What are the main tasks of the Regions council ?

Ans. The main tasks of the Regions council are –

1. Determine the needs of the region and propose their inclusion into the state's development plan.
2. Determine what projects are useful, arrange them in order of priority and their adoption as part of the annual state budget.
