A verb is a word that shows action. Verbs are also called action words.

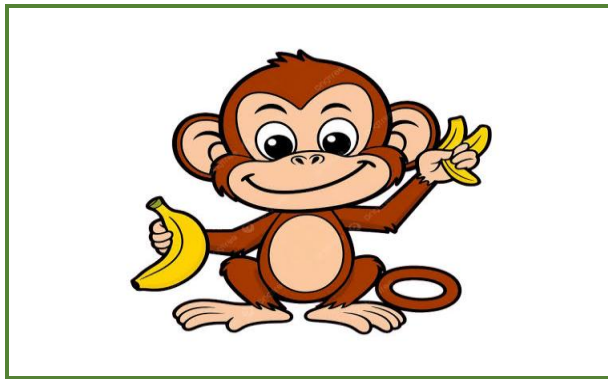
Eg: sing, walk, cook, read

Eg: She cooks food.
He draws pictures.
- We also add 's' when we use it with a proper noun or a common noun that talks about one thing.
Eg: Lina cleans her room.
